Our dedicated staff has high expectations for all students to learn and achieve to the best of their abilities. By incorporating various learning strategies, giving individual guidance and support and working with parents/guardians, we are confident that each student will have a successful experience at Uxbridge High School.

In order to be successful, there are some items that students need to have prior to the start of the 2010-2011 school year. Outlined below you will see some basic needs in each department, and in some cases for a specific class within a department.

English

- *3-ring binder dedicated solely to English – need dividers
- *Lined paper
- *Writing utensils
- *Index cards – 3x5 size

Family and Consumer Science

- *3-ring binder dedicated solely to FCS – need dividers
- *Writing utensils
- *Bottle of dish soap would be helpful

Performing Arts

- *Fundamentals of Guitar – acoustic guitars are preferred. Please have strings checked and tuned prior to class
- *Concert Band and Concert Choir are available as a class during the day AND after school

Visual Arts

- *3-ring binder dedicated solely to art (one for each art class student is taking)
- *Writing utensils for written assignments

- *3-ring binder dedicated solely to history
- *Writing utensils (black/blue pens)
- * Index cards – 3x5 size

Math

- *All students taking courses from Algebra I up through Calculus II are required to have their own graphing calculator. Recommended is *Texas Instrument TI83* or *TI84 plus*. It is encouraged that your child's name is engraved on the calculator.
- *3-ring binder dedicated solely to math
- *Pencils -- *all graded assignments are done in pencil*
- **Please note that the cost of a calculator can run from \$50 - \$100, so please be aware of sales and check EBay as another source to purchase a calculator.

Physical Education/Health

- *Sneakers and appropriate active wear
- *3-ring binder dedicated solely to Health
- *Writing utensils

Science

- *3-ring binder dedicated solely to science
- *Calculator
- *Writing utensils
- **Please note that these requirements are for the Physics/Technology class as well
