Entitlement

Title IV Part A - Safe and Drug Free School Communities #331

Grantee: *Massachusetts Department of Education through the NCLB Federal Program*

Purpose: *Open Circle Program at Taft*

Amount: *\$5,816 down from \$ 6,749*

Potential Amount: *Amount is set by DOE/Federal Government*

Funds used for Community of Caring training and program at the Middle and High Schools.

Title I #305

Grantee: *Massachusetts Department of Education through the NCLB Federal Program*

Purpose: *Reading assistance at Taft*

Amount: *\$168,922 up from \$ 164,753*

Potential Amount: *Amount is set by DOE/Federal Government*

Supports the title 1 reading program at Taft, primarily the title 1 reading teachers. In addition monies help support the DRA reading assessment/evaluation program, the Wilson reading specialist and professional development focused on reading.

Academic Support #632

Grantee: *Massachusetts Department of Education*

Purpose: *Provide school year and summer time support to students in grades 9-12 who haven't passed, or may not pass, the MCAS.*

Amount: *\$8,100 down from \$ 4,955 (school year) \$3,845 (summer)*

Potential Amount: *Amount is set by DOE/Federal Government*

MCAS support grant. Will be used this year for a school year program only, no summer program.

Title IIA - Teacher Quality #140

Grantee: *Massachusetts Department of Education through the NCLB Federal Program*

Purpose: *Reduction in classroom size at Taft and professional development*

Amount: *\$61,072 up from \$ 60,594*

Potential Amount: *Amount is set by DOE/Federal Government*

A portion of these funds are used to offset the cost of an additional teacher at Taft to reduce the class size, to offer professional development for teachers and to purchase PD materials.

Entitlement continued:

Title IID -Enhanced Ed thru Tech #160

Grantee: *Massachusetts Department of Education through the NCLB Federal Program*

Purpose: *Technology purchases and websites for teachers*

Amount: *\$2,114 up from \$ 2,035*

Potential Amount: *Amount is set by DOE/Federal Government*

This funding goes toward technologies that can improve the instructional strategies in the classroom. It will be used for professional development for teachers in technology and to purchase a portion of a Smartboard.

SPED 94-142 Allocation #240

Grantee: *Massachusetts Department of Education*

Purpose: *Offsets the costs of special education*

Amount: *\$492,449 up from \$ 472,098*

Potential Amount: *Amount is set by DOE/Federal Government*

This grant offsets the cost of special education. Funding is used for salaries for social workers/counselors, special education teachers, speech pathologists, paraprofessionals, and secretaries. This grant is often referred to as "94-142"

CPC Grant #391 & 395

Amount: *\$20,822 and \$212 down from 71,527 & 1,635.50*

Potential Amount: *predetermined amount*

A large portion of this grant has been allocated to a different portion of state government and therefore is no longer our responsibility. This grant is written in conjunction with the town of Northbridge and funds are used for local initiatives and pd for teachers.

CPC Grant #237

Written with the Northbridge coordinator a portion pays the coordinator costs and provides opportunities such as Health Fairs for the local community.
