BUDGET

Tuition collected thus far is \$162,403.75. During the months of November and December, our enrollment had increased for the after school program. This month, we have had two parents pull their children and a few who cut back on days because of a change in their job status. We will continue to update the school committee monthly on our progress.

GENERAL BUILDING OPERATIONS

Taft Elementary School held the H1N1 flu clinic. We worked together with Nurse Donatelli and other members of this clinic to share space (the gym and cafeteria). The staff was very creative in keeping the children engaged in other activities. Thank you to Mrs. Hazard and Mrs. O'Donnell for the use of their rooms.

The Extended Day program continues to assist the Taft & ELC office with calls from Vendetti Bus Company who are returning children back to the Taft school. We welcome the children to join in with our activities until their pick-up person arrives. Calls have been minimal this month.

OTHER

Our homework club remains one of our major components and staff is working together with classroom teachers to make sure students are receiving the best possible assistance and encouragement. Currently we have three children in the morning and five children in the afternoon who are taking advantage of the extra help programs offered by the academic staff. For the next several weeks we have several children being pulled for MCAS review. We have a number of our children who are able to participate in both the Tuesday and Thursday rehearsals for the 'Jungle Book' production. The value of our program is that these children are able to attend these extra activities and return safely to us for the remainder of the day. Their parents have expressed appreciation for this benefit.
