- *Go for a walk have a scavenger hunt use items and paint or decorate things they find
- *Draw with sidewalk chalk
- *Play hopscotch
- *Make a movement path with chalk
- *Write numbers or letters on the ground with chalk. Call them out and have your child spray them with a spray bottle (or call out addition and subtraction problems, sight words, etc.)
- *Play catch with different sized balls, bean bags

Imaginative Play:

- *Play beauty shop and let your child brush and do your hair
- *Play restaurant with any of their plates or cups, make menus with paper (use plastic food or make it out of paper/magazines)
- *Play doctor make tools to use out of paper stethoscope, arm cuff
- *Play school and let them teach you write letters, words, numbers on wipe boards, easels, paper on walls have them teach you how to do a project
- *Play veterinarian with all their stuffed animals
- *Play library and have them check out their books

Sensory Play:

- *Add measuring cups, funnels, spoons, small toys with the items listed below in a large bowl or container
- *Make oobleck (2 cups corn starch to 1 cup water, add food dye if desired)
